Errata dated 1905 in first edition "Ceol Mor" dated 1900.

I was very anxious to get these corrections ready for distribution amongst my friends at the different Highland Gatherings which I have attended during the past season, and with this view commenced working at the Press work in connection with them, early in the year; but after many disappointments I only succeeded in getting them in their present (to me) unsatisfactory form a day or two before the Northern Meeting, when I could not correct them as I should have. For many reasons, however, I thought it better to issue what I had than delay longer. Having adopted this course I must trust to the leniency of my friends, from whom I shall be always glad to hear as to errors, etc., addressed to me at 103 Warwick Road, Earl's Court, London, S.W. These corrections were intended to supplant other pages in the edition issued, but after personal experience I find that this pulls the book to pieces a good deal. I therefore request my friends to keep the corrections perfectly distinct from the book, merely noting in the Index of their book the pages that have been corrected.
